COUNCIL LEADERSHIP INTRODUCES REDISTRICTING ORDINANCE & MAPS

Indianapolis –The Indianapolis City-County Council agenda for Monday, April 4, includes Proposal 157, an ordinance outlining new Council districts proposed as part of the decennial redistricting process prescribed by state statute adopted by the Indiana General Assembly and signed into law. Co-sponsored by Council President Vop Osili, Vice President Zach Adamson, and Majority Leader Maggie A. Lewis, Proposal 157 is the result of a months-long process that began with a series of ten public forums designed to prioritize input from residents.

“For the first time in our city’s history, this Council positioned the voices of Indianapolis residents as the first and most critical step in the redistricting process,” stated Councillors Osili, Adamson, and Lewis. “Proposal 157 reflects what we heard from constituents during the “Your Voice 2022” public forums and our commitment to a process that was transparent, public-focused, and open to all. We offer our thanks to all those who participated in the public forums and gave their time and energy to articulating their own hopes and visions for their district's future.”
