## Man sentenced six years for role in 2022 Broad Ripple shooting

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind. – Marion County Prosecutor Ryan Mears announced that Damien Kimbrough has been sentenced to six years in the Indiana Department of Correction for his role in a shooting incident on Broad Ripple Ave. in July 2022. Kimbrough was convicted of Unlawful Possession of a Firearm by a Serious Violent Felon (Level 4 Felony), Pointing a Firearm (Level 6 Felony), and Resisting Law Enforcement (Class A Misdemeanor) in August.

In the early morning hours of July 31, 2022, Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Department officers were on patrol near the intersection of Broad Ripple and Guilford Avenues when they heard shots fired. Officers observed Kimbrough standing in the street with a firearm in his hand, pointing it at others around him.

Kimbrough attempted to flee on foot but was apprehended, and the firearm was recovered.
