Project Status

Interlocal Agreement (ILA)

- Draft has been delivered to the Town Board for review
- A PCA being prepared for Butler University

Design

- 60% design plans in internal review
- 90% plans will be prepared January/February 2023

Acquisition

- Relocation specialist information meetings complete
- Appraisal efforts underway resident contacts may begin before the end of the month
- In-structure visits are voluntary; considered an advantage

Environmental Permitting and Mitigation

- Preliminary discussions with agencies complete
- Aware of intent to mitigate local impacts will identify limitations

Project Update (cont'd)


Town Hall


