Marion County Prosecutor's Office to host Family Support Resource Day

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind. – Marion County Prosecutor Ryan Mears announced today that the office will host its Family Support Resource Day next month. The event will take place at the **Reset Center** located at **4330 N. Post Road**, on **Saturday, March 25, 2023**, from **10 a.m. – 2 p.m.**

The Family Support Resource Day will serve as a space for families in Marion County to access services that address their needs and concerns. More than 30 family service providers will be on-site to assist with child support inquiries, driver's license reinstatement, job training, housing and legal services, firearm storage education, and more. The Prosecutor's Office understands the need to maintain a healthy living environment and remains committed to building trust in our community by increasing access to specialized resources.

"Our relationship with the families of Marion County extends beyond the courtroom," Prosecutor Mears stated. "Creating spaces with access to vital services that may not be otherwise available promotes a safer and better place to live. We are proud to bring together community partners that share our efforts to provide stability and strength to families in our city."
