## City of Indianapolis SQU Approval Status and NJDEP Certification

Dear Recipient,

A Stormwater Quality Unit (SQU) approved by the City of Indianapolis Department of Public Works (DPW must have the current NJDEP certification, i.e., is listed on the NJCAT Technology Verification Database website.

If NJDEP Certification of the SQU lapses, the product will no longer be approved for use and will be removed from the DPW's approved list.

To reestablish the SQU on the City of Indianapolis "Approved" Selection Guide, the manufacturer, or manufacturer's representative, will be required to resubmit the product for re-approval with DPW, through the review process outlined in DPW's P.I.P.E Form. The P.I.P.E Form and the most current Approved SQU Selection Table can be found on District's webpage (https://www.indy.gov/activity/public-works-specifications-and-manuals).
