Dataniel Gilbert sentenced to 30 years for crash that killed two

Gilbert crashed into a vehicle causing the deaths of Delaney Frye and Nic Hatfield

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind. – Marion County Prosecutor Ryan Mears has announced that Dataniel Gilbert has been sentenced to 30 years in the Indiana Department of Correction for the Sept. 30, 2019 crash that resulted in the deaths of Delaney Frye and Nic Hatfield. Last week, Gilbert pleaded guilty to two counts of Failure to Remain at the Scene of an Accident Resulting in Death (Level 3 Felony).

The crash occurred on East 38 Street and North Keystone Avenue, when a blue pickup truck driven by Gilbert ran a red light. On the night of the incident, several witnesses saw Gilbert ejected from his vehicle. Gilbert left the scene of the incident but was eventually found and arrested.

Gilbert's blood alcohol concentration was 0.179% on the night of the crash.
