PROPOSAL NO. 206, 2022 - approves additional appropriations totalling \$15,000,000 in the 2022 Budgets of the Department of Public Works, Department of Parks and Recreation and Office of Finance and Management (Transportation General, Parks General and Consolidated County General Funds) to finance the design, construction and inspection of recreational and capital infrastructure projects, and for additional recruitment measures to address enterprise staffing needs

PROPOSAL NO. 213, 2022 - approves a speed limit reduction to 25 miles per hour in the Georgetown Crossing, Highwoods, Bonham Place, Wides 30th & Kessler, Green Hills, Wood Creek, Robertson Village, Cheswick Place, Fairway Woods, Northern Estates, Wolfington on Kessler Boulevard, and Arbordale Highlands subdivisions (District 8)
