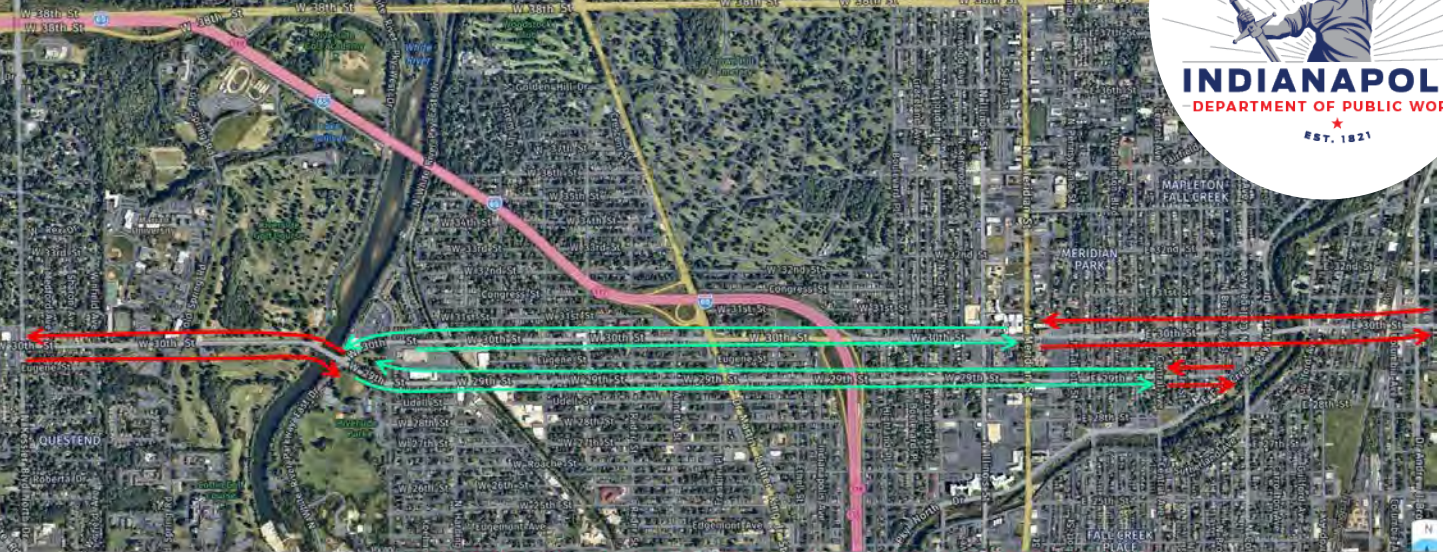


ST-17-052 - 29TH STREET AND 30TH STREET TWO WAY CONVERSION



Currently 1-Way, Proposed 2-Way Conversion Segments of 29th/30th Streets

Currently 2-Way Existing Segments of 29th/30th Streets

PROJECT DETAILS

This project will convert 29th Street between the White River and Central Avenue and 30th Street from White River to Meridian Street from one-way traffic to two-way traffic in 2023. Features of the conversion include improvements to existing sidewalks, curbs and ADA ramps, crosswalks, traffic calming elements and street resurfacing. These upgrades will increase safety and improve community access for residents, commuters, transit riders, pedestrians and bicyclists. Construction is expected in Spring 2023 with completion in late Fall 2024
