Andre Johnson sentenced 64 years for murder of Marlin Kiser

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind. – Marion County Prosecutor Ryan Mears announced today that Andre Johnson has been sentenced to 64 years in the Indiana Department of Correction for the January 2022 shooting of Marlin Kiser. Johnson was convicted in September of Murder and Unlawful Possession of a Firearm by A Serious Violent Felon (Level 4 Felony) after a two-day jury trial.

On January 30, 2022, IMPD officers located Kiser suffering from multiple gunshot wounds in the 12000 block of Aristocrat Drive North on the city's far eastside. Johnson was seen in video evidence approaching a vehicle, entering the back seat, and shooting the victim. Johnson then fled the scene in his vehicle.

Investigators were able to track Johnson back to his residence where he surrendered without incident. The murder weapon was later found during a search of Johnson's vehicle.

"We are pleased to bring justice for Marlin, his family and friends," Prosecutor Mears stated. "This resolution is yet another example of our community taking a stand against those who commit acts of violence."
