Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Department Officer Charged with Misdemeanor OVWI

INDIANAPOLIS - On December 10, 2025, at approximately 9:30 p.m., Officer Bryan Gibson arrived at the Southeast District in his personal vehicle for a scheduled administrative duty shift. Supervisors detected the odor of alcohol and made the appropriate notifications. An OVWI investigator, detectives from the Special Investigations Unit, and Internal Affairs responded to conduct an investigation. During the investigation, Gibson was determined to be under the influence of alcohol.

On December 11, 2025, Chief Bailey suspended Gibson without pay and recommended his termination to the Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Department (IMPD) Civilian Police Merit Board.

At the time of this incident, Gibson was assigned to administrative duty and did not have police powers while under administrative investigation for an unrelated personnel matter.

IMPD detectives presented the case to the Marion County Prosecutor's Office for a charging decision.

On December 17, 2025, the Marion County Prosecutor's Office filed charges against Gibson for operating a vehicle while intoxicated (OVWI) and operating a vehicle with a blood alcohol concentration (BAC) of .08 or higher. A summons was issued, and an initial hearing date is scheduled for January 20, 2026.

As with any person charged with a criminal offense, Gibson is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty in a court of law.
