Department of Business and Neighborhood Services Launches New Road Closure Viewer

Residents can use the tool to find up-to-date information about road projects, detours and special events in Indianapolis

INDIANAPOLIS – The Department of Business and Neighborhood Services (DBNS) has launched a new, interactive tool for the public to view current and upcoming road closures. The [new road closure viewer](#) gives residents the power to access critical information about various road projects, right-of-way permits and special events in one convenient location.

Designed to be user-friendly and easy to navigate, this new tool incorporates data from DBNS and the Department of Public Works (DPW) to provide a clear visualization of both city-led projects and private developments impacting the [right-of-way](#). Users can search Marion County addresses to see how their neighborhoods, workplaces or daily routes might be impacted by closures, and can easily obtain information about active permits.

“This new tool marks a significant step forward in the City’s commitment to make government service and information easier to access for the citizens we serve,” said Abbey Brands, director of DBNS. “This user-friendly format empowers citizens to stay informed and engaged in the work and events impacting their communities.”

Key features include:

- Daily updates, ensuring users have access to the most up-to-date information.
- Custom notifications, allowing users to outline an area on the map and be notified when permits are activated within those boundaries.
- Multiple data sets, providing toggling options to customize the map and date range.
- Detailed project information, including the project’s owner or permit holder, as well as the project name, description and start and end dates.

The closures displayed within the viewer are connected to permits that have already been approved and are either in progress or are scheduled to occur. Due to the potential for unforeseen circumstances related to construction activity, the dates associated with a closure may change. In the future, DBNS looks to further enhance this tool and provide greater public access to department data, including information about enforcement activity and other types of permits, such as drainage, zoning and structural.
