EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 3, 2026

DELEGATION TO INDY PARKS TO FACILITATE USE OF LUGAR PLAZA

WHEREAS, activation and use of public spaces by the citizens of the City of Indianapolis (“City”) is one of the Mayor’s goals; and

WHEREAS, in addition to informal gatherings and daily use of public spaces, the Department of Metropolitan Development (“DMD”) engages in and contracts for programming of public spaces as part of its mission to promote the use of land in the manner that best serves the interests of the City and its inhabitants, and

WHEREAS, the updated Lugar Plaza is one of the public spaces maintained by the Indianapolis-Marion County Building Authority (“IMCBA”); and

WHEREAS, per I.C. 36-10-3-3 and Sec. 241 of the Revised Code of the Consolidated City and County (collectively, “Code”), the Indianapolis Department of Parks and Recreation (“Indy Parks”) was established, and the Mayor can delegate duties to Indy Parks; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor delegates to Indy Parks authority to exercise its powers under the Code to coordinate with DMD, IMCBA, and other users and event hosts/planners to facilitate use of Lugar Plaza;


NOW, THEREFORE, under the authority vested in me as Mayor of the Consolidated City of Indianapolis and Marion County and executive officer of Marion County by state law and local ordinances, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Indianapolis Department of Parks and Recreation shall exercise all its powers and duties under the Code to facilitate and manage activities and events at Lugar Plaza, including but not limited to, coordination with DMD and IMCBA.

2. This Executive Order # 3, 2026 shall become effective immediately upon execution. And shall remain in effect unless and until terminated by executive order.
