## Shelby Street Bridge work begins in April

INDIANAPOLIS – Work on the Shelby Street bridge over Pleasant Run is expected to begin on or shortly after April 1. The bridge will be fully closed during construction and is expected to reopen in November.

The project will focus on strengthening and improving the bridge to ensure safe vehicular and pedestrian travel for years to come. While work is happening, drivers can follow the Fountain Square detour route. There will also be soft closures along the southern stretch of Shelby Street between Raymond Street and East Pleasant Run Parkway South Drive.

The city is coordinating with the Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) to align this work with ongoing I-65 expansion and other nearby improvements in the Fountain Square area. Drivers should plan for extra travel time and use caution in and around the work zone.
