



EMRICHSVILLE DAM REMOVAL PROJECT



PROJECT DETAILS

The purpose of this project is to remove the Emrichsville Dam on the White River which is located approximately 1,000 feet downstream of 16th Street. The scope of work is expected to include removal of the remnants of the dam in the river and rock placed during an emergency repair in 2018. The goals of the project are to improve safety and enhance river ecology. Construction site access is planned from the south bank from White River Parkway West Drive.
