There will be a meeting of the Metropolitan and Economic Development Committee of the City-County Council on **Monday, May 11, 2026**, beginning at **5:30 p.m.** in the **Public Assembly Room** of the City-County Building. It is anticipated that the following items may be considered by the Committee:

PROPOSAL NO. 123, 2026 - reappoints Gregg West to the Metropolitan Development Commission

PROPOSAL NO. 124, 2026 - approves an additional appropriation of \$42,000 in the 2026 Budget of the Marion County Recorder's Office (County Recorder's Perpetuation Fund) to be used for property fraud and Veterans honors advertisement

PROPOSAL NO. 125, 2026 - approves an additional appropriation of \$250,000 in the 2026 Budget of the Department of Metropolitan Development (Redevelopment General and Consolidated County General Funds) for the Vacant to Vibrant program

PROPOSAL NO. 126, 2026 - approves a payment in lieu of taxes (PILOT), as provided in IC 36-3-2-12, for an affordable housing project being financed in part with low-income housing tax credits, known as Central at Old Southside, consisting of 227 affordable housing units for low-income residents, located at 1406 and 1419 South Capitol Avenue and 1472 South Illinois Street (District 18)

PROPOSAL NO. 127, 2026 - directs the City-County Council to accept, for the record, the 2026 submission, for the 2025 calendar year, of the Tax Increment Finance (TIF) district financial report, pursuant to IC 36-7-15.1-36.3

PROPOSAL NO. 160, 2026 - approves a payment in lieu of taxes (PILOT), as provided in IC 36-3-2-12, for an affordable housing project being financed in part with low-income housing tax credits pursuant to Section 42 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, known as West Park consisting of 40 affordable housing units for low-income residents on the parcel located at 2302 West Morris Street, Indianapolis (District 17)

PROPOSAL NO. 134, 2026 - approves an additional appropriation of \$34,000 in the 2026 Budget of the Marion County Superior Court (Drug Free Community Fund) for the purpose of funding the initiative of the Drug Treatment Court and Re-entry Court project

PROPOSAL NO. 135, 2026 - approves an additional appropriation of \$4,830,000 in the 2026 Budget of the Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Department (State Grants, Federal Grants and IMPD General Funds) for the purpose of funding various grant awards not previously appropriated and Crime Gun Task Force grant cleanup
