Proceedings: The meeting was called to order by President Jennifer Norton at 6:04 pm.

The Board voted unanimously to endorse those findings as revised. The Director will schedule a time for the Board President to meet with the Police Chief to discuss the matter.

Case CPCO# 2021-012F; Carl Down Bey; Officer Christopher Williams:

Neither the complainant nor the officer was present for this case. Mr. Shearin summarized the case and the Director play a portion of the Body-Worn Camera video. After discussion, Mr. Shearing moved to accept the findings as listed in the case file. Mr. Gorman seconded the motion. The Board voted unanimously to endorse the findings.
