Dominic Johnson to serve 45 years for murder outside of downtown hotel

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind. – Marion County Prosecutor Ryan Mears announced today that Dominic Johnson has been sentenced to 45 years in prison for the May 2021 shooting of Will Edmond. Johnson pleaded guilty to Murder on the second day of his jury trial.

On May 11, 2021, IMPD officers responded to the Sheraton Hotel in downtown Indianapolis on a report of a person shot. Upon arrival, officers found Edmond on the street outside the hotel suffering from a gunshot wound. Edmond later died at a hospital as a result of his injuries.

Witnesses on scene described the shooter, later identified as Johnson, to officers and he was apprehended in a nearby alley in possession of the murder weapon.
