## Woman convicted of Voluntary Manslaughter for hitting and killing Andre Smith outside of bar

*Gaylyn Morris utilized an Apple AirTag to track Smith prior to the incident*

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind. – Marion County Prosecutor Ryan Mears announced today that Gaylyn Morris has been convicted of Voluntary Manslaughter (Level 2 Felony) for the June 2022 killing of Andre Smith. Morris was convicted after a three-day trial. A Level 2 Felony carries a sentence up to 30 years.

On June 3, 2022, the Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Department was dispatched to a crash in a parking lot outside of a bar in the 3900 block of E. 82nd St. When officers arrived, they located Smith underneath Morris' car. He was pronounced dead at the scene.

Witnesses stated that Morris was searching for her boyfriend utilizing an Apple AirTag device. When Morris entered the bar, Smith was there with another woman, and an altercation ensued. After the three exited the bar, Morris got into her vehicle and ran over Smith multiple times. Morris was detained at the scene.

A sentencing hearing has been scheduled for Sept. 21 at 10 a.m.

This is the third conviction that the Prosecutor's Office has obtained this week in homicide cases.
